What you'll learn

This is a hands-on course utilizing practical demonstrations and exercises, along with simulations to enable students to learn:

- How to properly protect, contain and manage a crime scene.
- Proper collection, preservation and documentation of physical evidence and how to meet the legal requirements for collected evidence.
- Use a variety of evidence collection, impression and casting techniques for the lifting of fingerprints, shoe, tire impressions, etc.
- Identify, analyze and interpret basic fingerprints, imprints or castings.
- Crime scene documentation using sketches, still and video photography.

The instructor for this course is Nancy Torres, Senior Forensics Technician with the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department.

Location & Parking

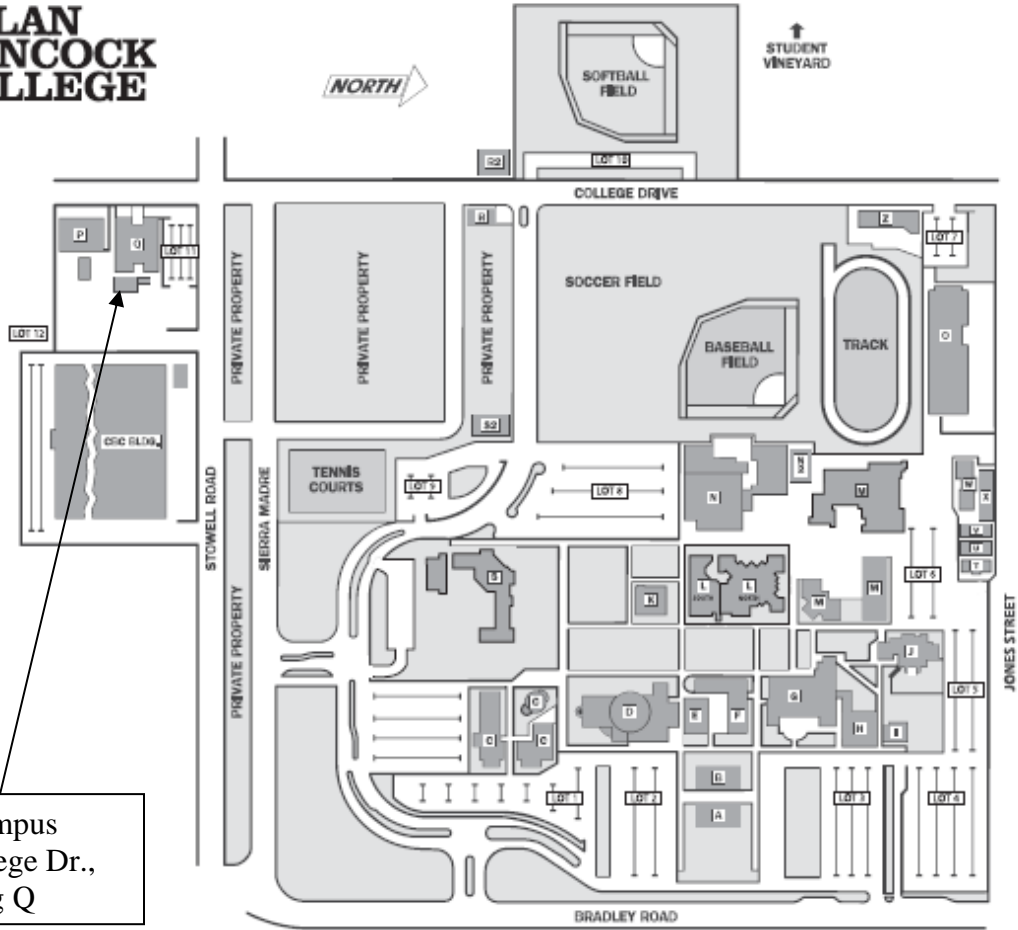
